Information for health personnel

In the case of accident: Contact a doctor or casualty department – take the label or this safety data sheet. Contact a doctor if in doubt about the injured person's condition or if the symptoms persist.

Upon breathing difficulties or irritation of the respiratory tract: Bring the person into fresh air and stay with him/her

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water and soap. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Ensure to wash exposed skin thoroughly with water and soap. DO NOT use solvents or thinners. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.



Fire fighting procedures
